- 3. Provide high level individualized patient and client care as well as support for local veterinarians, as per VETDERM Clinic philosophy.

Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities

The dermatology intern would be exposed to various duties and tasks performed by a dermatologist with progressive increase in patient care involvement and responsibility during the internship. A learning environment is available through patient care and exposure, dermatology procedures, didactic learning, client communications during 4 day patient intake weeks. The intern will be expected to immerse themselves in this learning environment and support the dermatology team in providing gold standard care to patients and clients.

The intern will be involved in the receiving and care of companion animals with skin and ear diseases. Participation in weekly rounds including Dermatology Journal Club, Patient Case Rounds, Cytological Training, Dermatology Topic Reviews, Basic Science Reviews, etc. is also expected.

The intern will also be expected to be involved in the teaching of senior veterinary students and visiting veterinarians. A publication is highly encouraged with retrospective and prospective studies as well as case report opportunities available during the internship.

A "Certificate of Internship" will be issued following successful completion of the internship program.
